## Pool Projects

We informed you last year of the Virginia Graeme Baker Law that went into affect in December 2008. This law requires that all pools have dual main drains ( or a few other acceptable options) to avoid entrapment situations. The law is a good one for the safety of swimmers but was vague in how to conform to it. We now know we must put in a dual main drain in

the main pool and are working to find options for the baby pool. We are working with the Health Dept. and other specialists in the aquatics field. A major part of the process is getting a plan review completed and submitted to King County for permits. This must be done by an Aquatic Architect not the board or pool manager. The project is being overseen

by Crystal Lee the pool manager who will in turn keep the board informed of the progress. It is our hope to have the work completed before the season begins. If you want to know more, you can join us at the Board Meetings. There is no special assessment for this work, your board has reserved money for this sort of situation.
