Registration will begin soon for the High Woodlands Dolphins Summer Swim Team. High Woodlands Dolphins is a competitive swim team for children of all abilities. It's loads of fun and a great way to meet and spend time with other families in the neighborhood. The only requirement to join is that a child be able

to swim the length of the pool (25 yards) without touching the bottom. High Woodlands Dolphins swim as part of the Midlakes Swim League.

Practices will begin in mid-May during the evenings, Monday through Thursday. Once school is out, practices switch to the morning. Meets will take place in June and July. We swim as part of Division V of Midlakes, which means we swim only one meet per week. All practices and home swim meets take place at our neighborhood pool. Swim team registration will begin in April.
